
DECLARING NO-TRUMP

- 1. Review the auction (did the opponents bid?)
- 2. What does the lead suggest?
- 3. Count your winners.
- 4. Look for extra tricks that you can develop.
- 5. Play the suit that will give the best chance for extra tricks safely.
- 6. Don't be afraid to give up the lead if it will lead to extra tricks for your contract.
- 7. The "hold up play" is a common way to help declarer disrupt the defenders communication when they have a long suit to run.

DEFENDING NO-TRUMP

- 1. THE 4TH BEST LEAD is king against NT contracts. (1+ honor)
- 2. TOP OF NOTHING is a nice passive lead. (no honors)
- 3. Top of touching honors is only ok when you have 3 touching honors. (With only 2, lead 4th best)
- 4. Returning partner's 4th best lead is almost always right, unless you have knowledge of a better strategy for your side.
- 5. SIGNAL when you are able to and watch for partner's signals.
 - This is the most important seat at the table PAY ATTENTION ©








IT IS NICE WHEN WE HAVE ONE OF THESE STANDARD LEADS AVAILABLE IN OUR HAND.


THE CARDS IN BOLD ARE CONSIDERED STANDARD LEADS. (note the slight differences when we are defending vs. suits & no-trump.)



PASSIVE LEADS

Passive opening leads are made when we fear giving up tricks to the other side with our lead.



WHEN TO BE PASSIVE

LEVEL

The lower the level, the more likely a passive lead will work.


We almost always lead passively against Slams.

STRENGTH

The stronger declarer's hand is, the more passive you want to be.

AGGRESSIVE LEADS

Aggressive opening leads are made when we are in a rush to get our tricks. We fear they may go away if we don't hurry.



WHEN TO BE AGGRESSIVE

SIDE SUITS


If either dummy or declarer have shown a strong side suit, an aggressive lead is frequently best.


SHAPE


The more shape the declarer has, the more likely they will be able to pitch losers away quickly. Aggressive leads can help to establish our side's tricks prior to declarer pitching away those losers.



















NO – TRUMP LEADS VS. SUIT LEADS

NO - TRUMP LEADS

4th BEST FROM YOUR LONGEST & STRONGEST

LEADING AWAY FROM HONORS IS EXPECTED

SET UP YOUR LONG SUITS AS QUICKLY AS YOU CAN

WE WANT TO SCORE TRICKS WITH OUR SMALL CARDS (LENGTH)

USUALLY STAY AWAY FROM OPPONENTS' SUITS

UNLESS WE CAN SEE A SOURCE OF TRICKS FOR OUR SIDE

PARTNER'S SUIT IS GOOD, BUT NOT ALWAYS RIGHT.

HOW MANY PTS. DOES PARTNER HAVE? DO THEY HAVE ENTRIES? IS THERE SOMETHING BETTER?

SUIT LEADS

WE USUALLY LEAD PASSIVELY HERE

EXCEPT WHEN THE AUCTION TELLS US THERE MAY BE URGENCY

LEAD SINGLETONS FOR RUFFS

EASY WAY TO GET EXTRA TRICKS AGAINST SUITS.

DON'T TRY TO BE A GENIUS ON THE LEAD

MAKING "NORMAL" LEADS IS A GOOD WAY TO STAY WITH THE FIELD

LEAD UNBID SUITS

WE CAN FREQUENTLY FIND/DEVELOP TRICKS IN THESE SUITS

LEADING TRUMP CAN BE RIGHT FOR MANY REASONS

DON'T LEAD SINGLEETON TRUMPS

LEADING STRATEGIES FOR DIFFERENT CONTRACTS

NO - TRUMP LEADS

TYPICALLY AGGRESSIVE LEADS

TRY TO SET UP OUR LENGTH

TRICKS ARE NOT AS LIKELY TO GO AWAY

COMMON NO-TRUMP LEADS

4TH BEST FROM LONGEST TOP OF NOTHING TOP OF 3 TOUCHING HONORS

SUIT LEADS

TYPICALLY PASSIVE LEADS

TRY NOT TO GIVE UP TRICKS

*When leading doubletons vs. suit contracts, we will usually need a trump entry in our hand also.
















BASIC DEFENSIVE STRATEGIES GUIDELINES FOR BEST RESULTS

2ND HAND LOW

RARELY WRONG TO FOLLOW THIS BASIC RULE OF BRIDGE.









3RD HAND HIGH

RARELY WRONG TO FOLLOW THIS BASIC RULE.*

*When there is an honor in dummy, we might NOT play 3rd hand high.







BEST PRACTICES

MAKE THESE THINGS PART OF YOUR HABITS FOR EVERY HAND YOUR SIDE IS DEFENDING FOREVER ©

Figure out your partner's range of high card points as soon as dummy goes down. (this is hard at first, but practice will produce speed & accuracy)

Lead / Return partner's suit.

SIGNAL YOUR PARTNER

WATCH PARTNER'S SIGNALS

Make tough decisions early if possible. (i.e. will you play 2nd hand low when they lead towards the K in dummy?)

Try your best to figure out declarer's shape.



OUR BIDDING "SYSTEM"







A NON – JUMP RESPONSE OF A NEW SUIT AT THE TWO LEVEL WILL BE GAME FORCING (13+ points) WHEN;

*note, this denies 3 card support


Failing to do either of these should always deny both support and stoppers.




